Awards

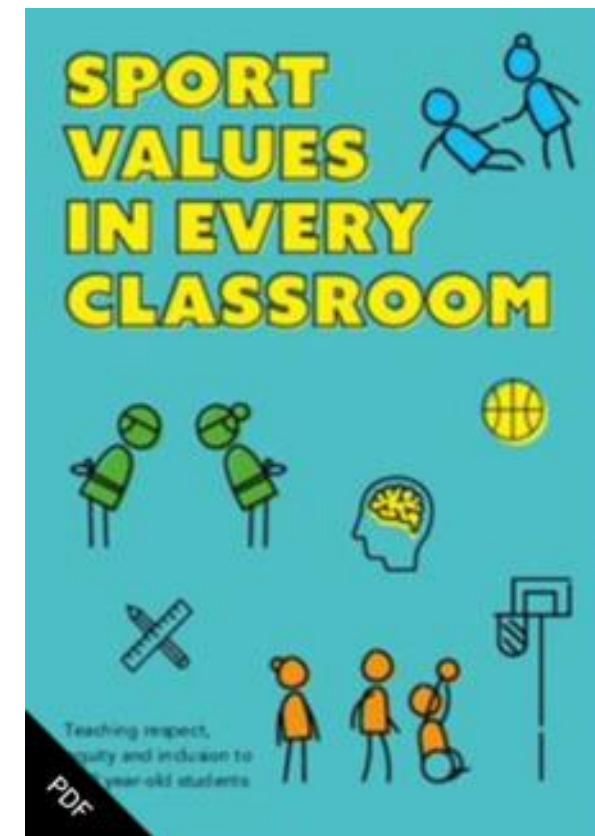
- **1 pc EWF Fair Play Award/Trophy** based on all the nominees during the year. Suggestion could be done by anybody basically for Fair Play Acts.
